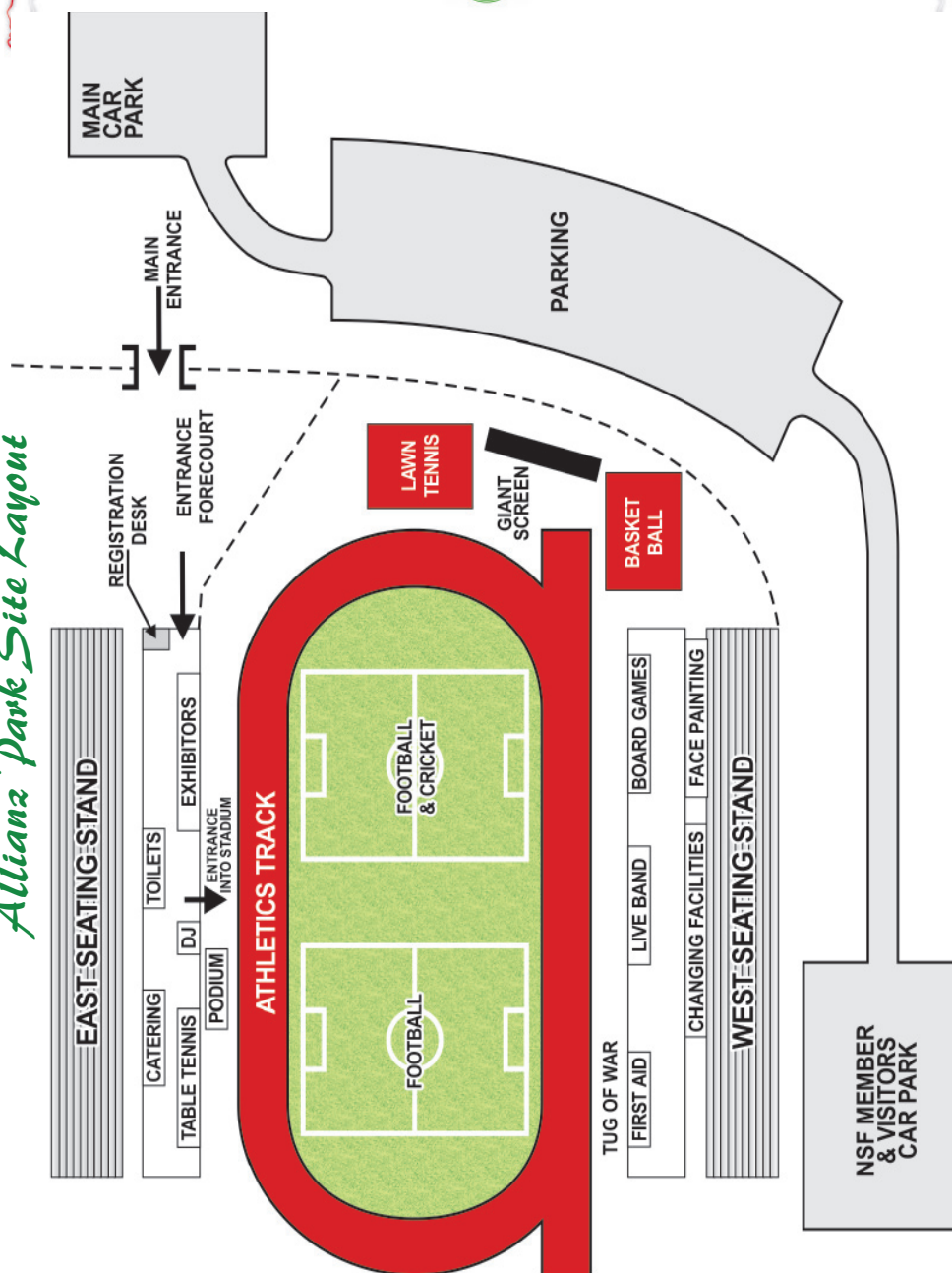

The broad aim of the Britain-Nigeria Educational Trust is to promote friendship and understanding between the UK and Nigeria by providing financial support that directly contributes to the progress and advancement of education in Nigeria. It is a non-political and non-sectarian membership charity managed by a Board of Trustees who meet at least three times a year. The Board's policy on grants is to select projects that will contribute positively to the improvement of education, especially in areas where others are slow to help.

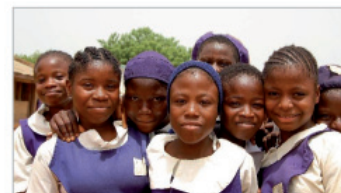
Teacher training is a key priority with support given to the placement of VSO volunteers in this role as well as assisting deserving teachers to raise their skills through the Trust's Tafawa Balewa Teacher Award scheme and the Distant Learning Programme run by the National Teachers Institute, Kaduna.

Current major educational projects include the building of a new secondary school for girls in Umutu, the construction and furnishing of a new 2 storey 6-classroom block and a student hostel complex for Edo College and a new classroom and laboratory block for King's College, Lagos. Grants for books, equipment and teaching facilities are regularly given to other schools and colleges.

As part of the Trust's strategy to make a noticeable impact on education a five-year Fellowship Plan has been awarded to Ibadan University to assist its planned programme of development as an international centre for postgraduate training and research. The Fellowship funds the placement of a senior academic to work with the university in all aspects of teaching, supervision, mentoring and research.

A valuable and regular income is derived through the annual subscription of its members. Additional funding is generated from investments, corporate sponsorships, voluntary donations, legacies and the sale of its annual Christmas card and other merchandise.

The Trust is dependent on financial support from individuals, institutions and companies who share our charitable purpose. 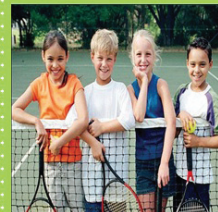

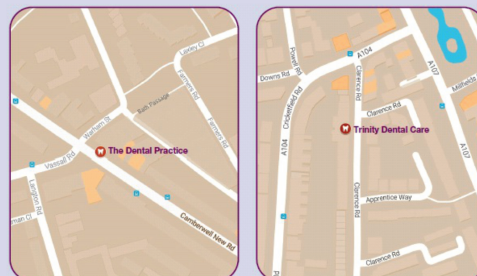

The incidence of Diabetes among the BME community which includes Nigerians is

quite high. There are 3.8 million people in the UK living with diabetes, including 850,000 people who have Type 2 diabetes but don't know it. Some of them are Nigerians and this number continues to rise. Physical activity and exercise play a key role in the prevention and treatment of Type 2 Diabetes.

In June this year, NSF (UK) hosted a presentation given to members by Mistura Yusuf on the risks surrounding Diabetes among BME groups. Mistura is a volunteer for the Heal-D project and Diabetes UK and her role involves raising awareness of type 2 diabetes in all communities and encouraging others to become volunteers.

While attending the NSF(UK) 6th Sports and Family Fun Day on Bank holiday Sunday 27th August 2017, at the Allianz Park, Hendon NW4 1RL, you'll have an opportunity to visit the Diabetes UK stand, where Mistura and other Diabetes UK Community Champions will be carrying out assessments of people at risk of developing Type 2 diabetes.

Heal-D is a King's College London project initiative that seeks to improve treatment outcomes for people of African and Caribbean origin with diagnosis of type 2 diabetes. Diabetes UK is a charity initiative that cares, connects and campaigns for people with or at risk of having Diabetes, to ensure people with diabetes do not suffer.

This event will also provide a forum to discuss the risks of Nigerians in Diaspora developing Diabetes, what this means in terms of becoming physically active and the difference the NSF (UK) event can make in providing an avenue for engagement with the wider Nigerian community.

Mistura's presentation focussed on the two main types of Diabetes, type 1 and type 2. She explained that people with type 1 diabetes produce very little, if any insulin while those with type 2 diabetes do not produce enough insulin or the insulin they do produce does not function properly. The two conditions are quite different, with different causes and the treatments can be different, too. Both conditions are however serious and could

Opened in August 2016, in Tema, on the outskirts of Accra, Ghana, ASA is a sixth-form college leading to globally respected Cambridge International A Levels. ASA runs a one-year program consisting of 3 core subjects at Advanced level in a boarding school environment for young women with outstanding maths and science potential. Academically gifted students with a passion for maths and science are specifically selected. These students apply from across Africa and are admitted after their senior secondary education in preparation for progression to the best universities in Africa and around the world. ASA is a pathway to undergraduate study and future careers in Engineering, Science, Computing and more.

The Academy, officially launched on Friday 3rd February 2017, has a vision to be the leading school in Africa for gifted young scientists. The many nationalities which make up the ASA community contribute to the rich and diverse cultural atmosphere, where maths, science and technology are taught to young women in an inclusive environment.


Founded by African Gifted Foundation Ghana, a registered Ghanaian NGO, a subsidiary of the African Gifted Foundation, a UK registered charity. ASA's journey began with Dr. Tom Ilube, Chair and founder who also received the prestigious award of the most influential black person in the UK for 2017.

with ASA providing them a sense of vision and purpose to take over the STEM world in Africa. These girls left their home countries; Cameroon, Ethiopia, Nigeria, Sierra Leone, Togo, Uganda and different parts of Ghana to be a part of the pioneering class at the Academy. This first cohort of ASA students sat the Cambridge International A levels in Maths, Further maths, Physics in 12 months and about two thirds (65%) achieved the grades A*-B. One 16 year old girl got A*A*A. The overall pass rate (A*-D) was 100%.

Although it is a fee paying school, ASA has a fully funded scholarship program which can cover up to 100% of fees and expenses. One of those privileged to win such a scholarship is Aisha Akinola, a student of Federal Government College Sokoto who won the 2017/2018 African Science Academy Scholarship Award, facilitated by the Nigerian Schools Foundation (UK) also known as NSF(UK). All qualified students across the nation were invited to Abuja for a written examination on Mathematics, Further Mathematics, Physics and essay writing. Aisha Akinola emerged as the only Nigerian girl among 24 Gifted Girls selected from across African Continent securing a Scholarship Admission for a one year programme for the Cambridge International A-Level. She left for Tema, Ghana on 1st August, 2017 in the company of her proud father as an ambassador of F.G.C Sokoto and Nigeria as a whole.

The College have expressed their appreciation to the UK Chapter of the Old Students Association and NSF (UK) for
